

Context Information - Academy

The Head of Academy, Mrs Elaine Jupp, started in January 2016 with a new executive principal, Mrs Gail Young, in post from January 2017.

The KS2 and KS1 leaders, new Assistant Principals from September 2017, are now part of the senior leadership team. The extended leadership team will comprise of an English Leader and a Mathematics leader from September 2017. The SENCo, appointed for September 2017, teaches part-time.

There are 14 classes in total.

We currently have 379 pupils on roll, including 42 in the nursery.

In terms of deprivation, the academy is in the top 20% in the country with 89% of pupils living in the 10% most deprived homes.

Pupil movement is low, therefore our pupil population is very stable compared with the national picture.

10% of our pupils are from ethnic minority backgrounds compared to 32% nationally with 7.2% of pupils having English as an additional language – the national figure is 20%.

The number of pupils eligible for the Pupil Premium Grant is over twice the national figure at 54.3%.

The number of pupils with special educational needs is broadly in line with the national figure at 25.2%.

The current Ofsted judgement is Requires Improvement.
