

## PE and Sports Premium for Primary Schools Impact Review

### 2017 – 2018

In 2017-18 Willoughby Road Primary Academy will receive the fifth year instalment of PE funding. The funding will be used in a variety of ways to further improve and develop teaching and learning across the whole academy. We will encourage pupils to lead healthy lifestyles, enjoy PE and Sport and experience high quality teaching. They will be encouraged to take part in competition and aim for sporting excellence. We have employed a specialist sports coach to deliver extra-curricular clubs and develop opportunities for a wider range of sports offered, allowing our children to be able to compete against other schools in our locality.

Having already seen impact of the funding from the previous 4 years we expect for this additional funding to have continued and sustained impact on provision of PE and sport within our academy. Learning walks, lesson observations and monitoring by SLT and the PE leader have identified the following areas to address in PE this year: high quality coaching in KS1 and KS2, increased awareness of healthy lifestyles, increased time of vigorous exercise throughout the school day. Pupils of all ages and abilities will also have opportunities to participate in competitive events in various locations in the local area. We will raise sporting aspirations of our young people and encourage them to participate in a wide range of sports in and out of the academy.
